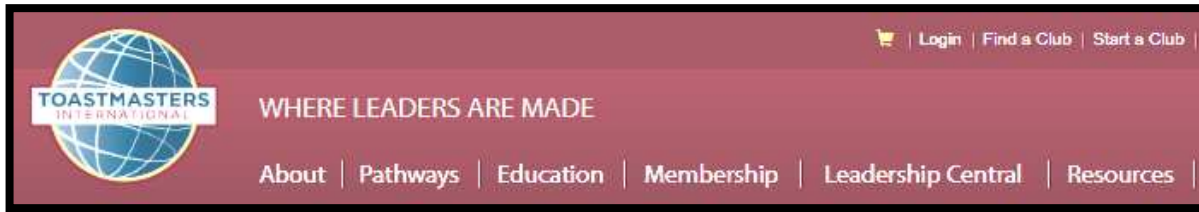


1. Go to [toastmasters.org](https://toastmasters.org) and click on Login

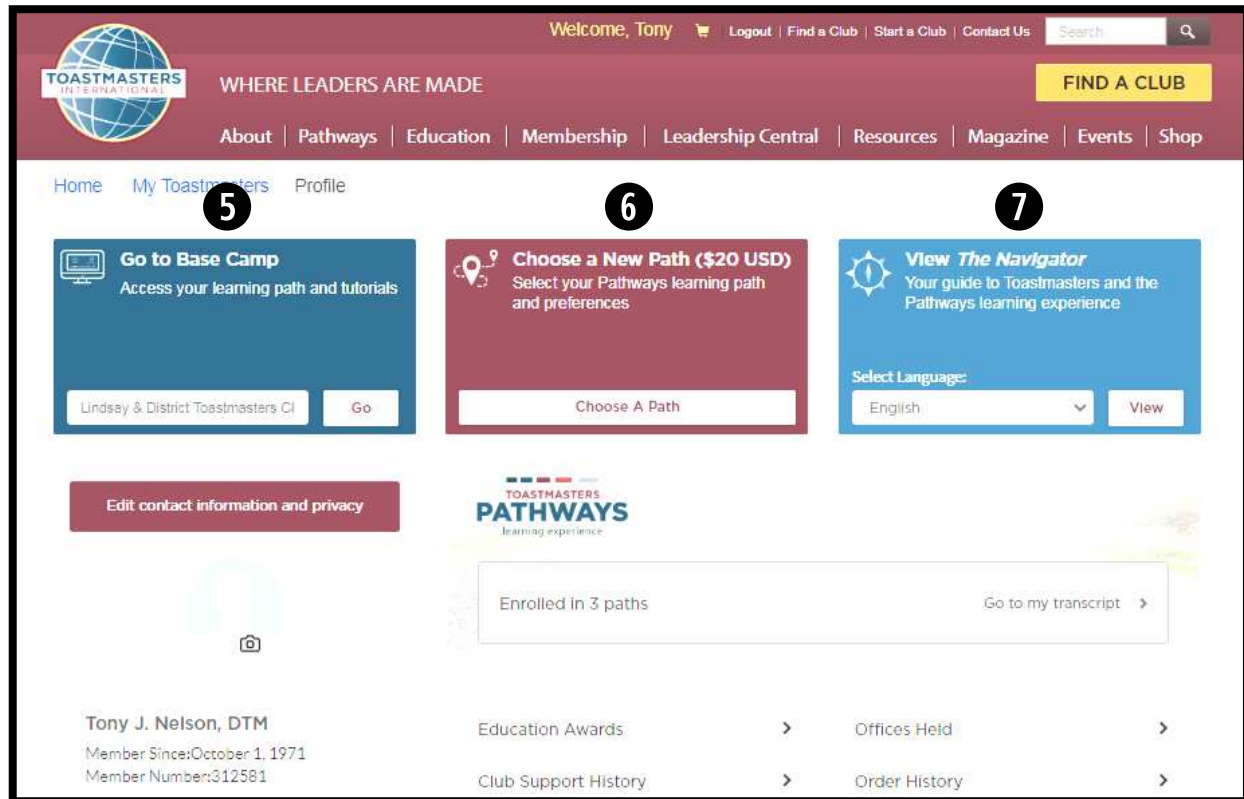
- 1 Enter Username, Email which you gave Toastmasters or your Member ID

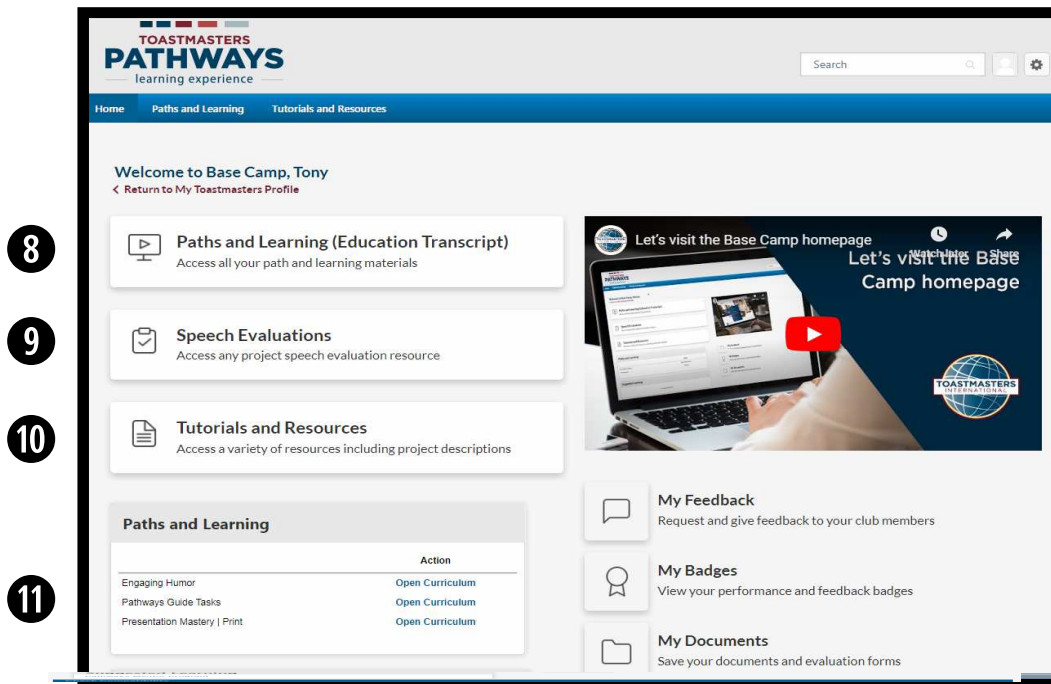
