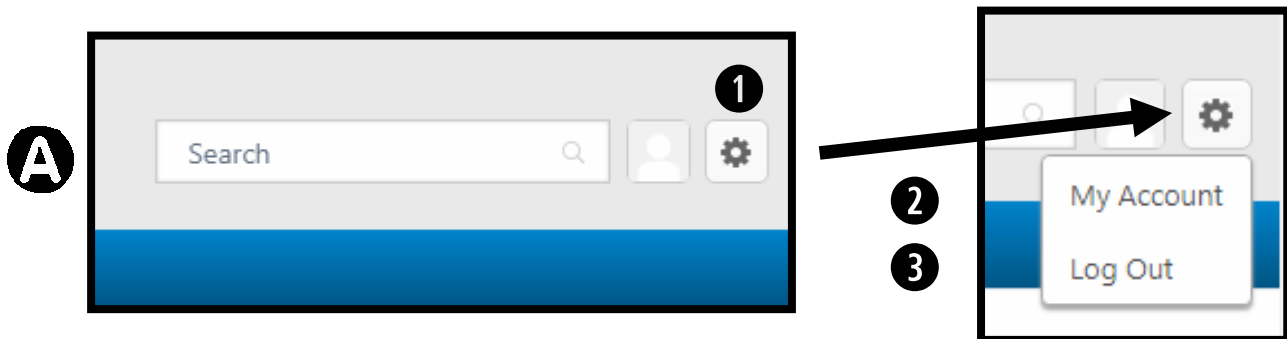
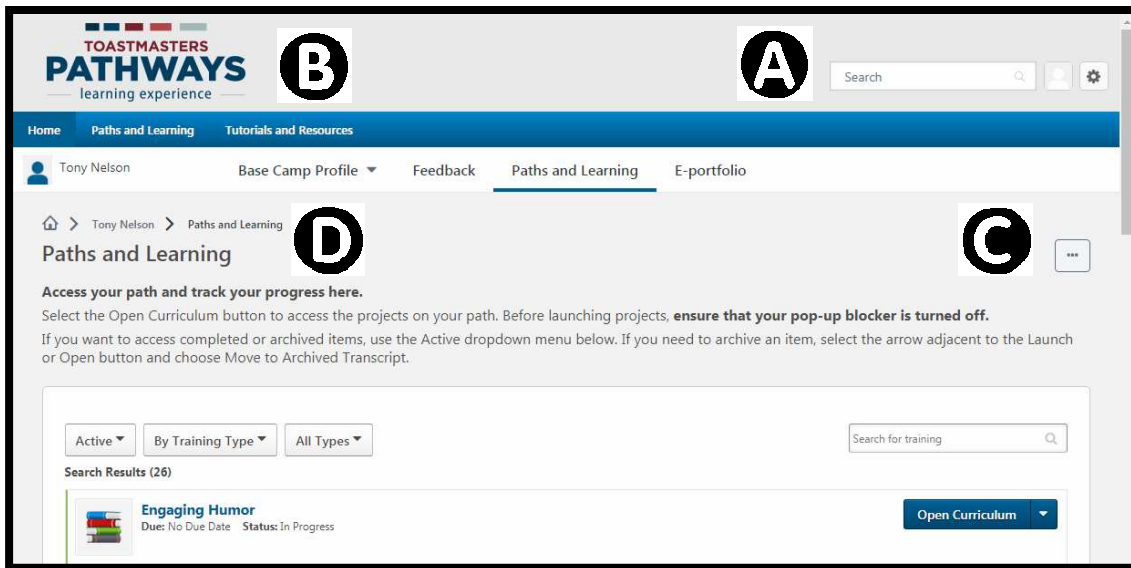

Click on **1** GEAR to expose **My Account** and **Log Out**

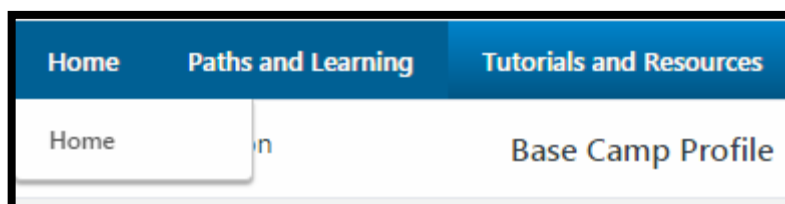
Click **2** **My Account** to enter completed meeting role dates
